The Douglass Community Services, Inc. – CASA Advisory Council shall consist of no more than fifteen (15) professionals and community members.

The Advisory Council, both as individuals and as a group, shall act in an advisory capacity to the CASA Program Director of the Tenth Judicial Circuit as well as serve as liaisons to the community on behalf of CASA. The Advisory Council shall assist the CASA Program Director in planning, evaluating, and implementing the program. The Advisory Council may take the following issues under advisement:

1. Program Policies
2. Program Development
3. Volunteer Management

4. Services Provided by CASA
5. Conflicts and Concerns that Arise as a Result of CASA Involvement

The CASA Advisory Council shall meet at least twice a year, meeting times and places as established by the group.

For the purposes of voting, a quorum shall consist of a simple majority of the members. Members who have more than three consecutive unexcused absences of regularly scheduled meetings shall be deemed no longer interested in the DCS - CASA Program and may be removed from council membership.
